In the correspondence section of this agenda item (4.5) highlights the 17<sup>th</sup> annual Northeastern Fire Education Conference being held on March 26<sup>th</sup> through March 29th 2015. This conference covers all aspects of effectively maintaining a Fire Department as well as administration, training, volunteer retention and fire prevention. The cost of the conference is approximately \$310 per person for registration, plus accommodation and per diem. Since the conference is out of town we also purchase a banquet ticket for the Fire Chief and Deputy Chief's wives. Normal travel policy applies. It has been the practice to also send the Fire Department Chairperson to attend this conference.
