The John Dixon Public Library was formally established by By-law 64-19 under Provincial legislation as a Public Library in the Town of Mattawa by Mattawa Council in 1964.

The library has provided a very worthwhile service to our area over the years and under the Public Libraries Act, the Municipal Council shall appoint at least five members to sit on the Board. Qualifications include being at least eighteen years of age, a Canadian citizen, and a resident of Mattawa.

An advertisement was placed in the Mattawa Recorder in January seeking applications from interested persons to sit on the John Dixon Public Library Board for the term of Council. A total of four applications were received, which all qualify, therefore it is recommended to appoint these 4 applicants plus myself which will form the Board of Directors for the John Dixon Public Library Board.
