### Mayor D. Backer and Members of Council:

Council has declared the 2002 Ford F150 as a surplus vehicle to the municipality. The Recreation Department has not yet replaced this vehicle in our municipal fleet.

We have placed an ad in the Mattawa Recorder inviting a minimum sealed bid of \$500.00 from the public for the sale of this surplus item. A bid form which included details of the vehicle, and other information pertaining to the process, was made available for pick up at the Municipal Office as of October 5, 2015. Bids had to be submitted in accordance with the form by Friday, October 16, 2015.

We have received one sealed bid and it was opened in the presence of the Clerk, By-Law Officer, and the Treasurer on October 22, 2015. Mr. Robert Rockburn of 241 Fifth Street in Mattawa submitted a \$510.00 bid accompanied with a 10% deposit.

### Mayor D. Backer and Members of Council:

The North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority (NBMCA) owns the land, buildings and ski lifts in the Laurentian Escarpment Conservation Area which provide for the operation of a ski hill. The Laurentian Ski Hill and Snowboarding Club (LSHSC) has been responsible for all expenses related to the operation and maintenance of the ski hill, including the NBMCA-owned fixed assets.

The LSHSC, together with NBMCA, engaged BDO to perform a Business Strategic Review of the ski hill operations and develop a Business Plan that would set a new path forward. The Plan also recognizes that the LSHSC cannot shoulder the financial burden of maintaining the NBMCA-owned fixed assets.

The upkeep of the fixed assets will require an average of \$65,000 over the next 5 years. Separation of the major fixed capital requirements from operational activities will ensure that the ski hill management team can focus on operational results.

The Board is asking each of the 10 member municipalities to commit to assisting with funding these NBMCA-owned fixed assets for the next five years. This is not a levy, but an "ask" that is based on the apportionment formula provided by the province.

#### **Recommendation:**

That the Town of Mattawa commits to assisting with funding the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority owned fixed assets at the Laurentian Ski Hill and Snowboarding Club with an annual contribution of \$745 for the next five years.

Council supports the importance of a feeder system for the long term survival of Antoine Mountain and also recognizes this funding assistance to the NBMCA as an economic development opportunity.
