#### Mayor D. Backer and Members of Council:

In the correspondence section of the August 22, 2016 agenda, a letter (4.7) from the City of North Bay requested all northern Ontario municipalities support their resolution to request the Government to consider exempting Northern Ontario from the natural gas price hikes under Cap and Trade proposals. And further, that the Government review and consider eliminating this proposed increase of 4.3 cents per litre, at least in Northern Ontario, due to the impact it would have on residential and community members already facing economic challenges.

Council spoke to this request and agreed a resolution of support was in order.

The Ontario Good Roads Association and the Ontario Road Salt Management Group are hosting a three-day Snow School course as part of their Winter Maintenance Operations Training. This course is being held in Alliston, Ontario September 26-28, 2016 at a cost of \$1,500.00 plus HST which also includes accommodations and meals.

Some of the course content includes Environment Canada's Code of Practice and MOE's Local Source Water Protection, minimum maintenance standards, records management, inspection of winter maintenance equipment, pre and post season operations, snow and ice control materials and techniques, salt management and winter operations plans.

The Public Works Supervisor has expressed interest in attending this worthwhile training as it will be very beneficial to gain knowledge on the latest trends and municipal winter maintenance practices, equipment and materials.
