Recycling Information

Three separate containers are required for recycling.

Bin #1: Metals and Plastics

Plastics with recycling logo #1-7 as per below are the only plastics acceptable for recycling



- Metal cans
- Soft drink cans
- Aluminum containers
- Aluminum foil
- Plastic bottles, jars and jugs
- Tubs and tub lids (yogurt, sour cream, hand cleaner, margarine containers)

Bin #2: Paper

- Newspaper and flyers
- Magazines and catalogues
- Telephone books
- Fine paper such as writing paper, computer paper, paper pads, advertising mail
- Paper gift wrap (no wax type), greeting cards
- Clean paper shopping bags or paper packaging

Bin #3: Cardboard (A container is not mandatory for the cardboard; it can be bound together)

- Corrugated cardboard
- Cereal and cracker boxes (liners removed)
- Shoe and laundry detergent boxes
- Paper egg cartons, toilet paper and paper towel rolls
- Frozen dinner boxes
