#### Mayor D. Backer and Members of Council:

Council budgeted for a replacement vehicle for the By-law, Building Department during this budget process. The existing 2003 Sonoma would have needed approximately \$4500.00 in repairs and maintenance, such as brakes, ball joints, tie rod end replacement, emission control repairs, tires and some body work to keep this vehicle on the road.

Dan Monette was approached to look for a used vehicle which would suit our needs. Mr. Monette has located a 2010 Ford Ranger Extended Cab 4X4 with 52,000 kms on it. It is in excellent shape for \$18,356.00 including taxes and administration fees.

#### Mayor D. Backer and Members of Council:

Whispering Pines Native Non Profit Housing Inc. approached the Town of Mattawa in 2013 about the possibility of acquiring land for their funding proposal request (FIMUR) to build a 10 unit seniors housing complex.

Council adopted resolution 13-41 November 4<sup>TH</sup>, 2013 which stated:

- That the Town of Mattawa supports in principal a proposal of Whispering Pines Native Non-Profit Homes Inc. for a ten-unit senior's housing development on vacant municipal land at the intersection of Turcotte Park Road and James Street.
- Depending on the site plan requirements: the municipality will donate Lot 104, Registered Plan 7 and if required for the development close and donate Wood Street adjacent to Lot 104, and if required donate the island triangle surrounded by Wood, James and Turcotte Park Road.
- The municipality supports and will upon application by Whispering Pines Native Non-Profit Homes Inc.:
  - o undertake a rezoning for the development
  - o process a road closing by responding to a surplus land policy consideration by Whispering Pines Native Non-Profit Homes Inc. with the intention of processing the legal requirements per Provincial and municipal policies and transferring ownership to Whispering Pines Native Non-Profit Homes Inc. of those lands required for the development at no cost to Whispering Pines Native Non-Profit Homes Inc.
- The municipality agrees to provide up to a maximum of \$10,000 in third party expenses for legal, surveying and engineering expenses.

- It is further understood this commitment is subject to Whispering Pines Native Non-Profit Homes Inc. receiving approval from FIMUR through the December 2013 Ontario Aboriginal Housing Services Program call for the ten-unit project. Council will co-operate and process the rezoning, engineering, surveying costs, legal work for transfers of land, etc. as described in the Public Works report presented to Council October 21, 2013.
- It is also further understood any development costs, above the \$10,000 municipal commitment including the possibility of any required servicing upgrades, Turcotte Park Road realignment, and all site development costs will be the responsibility of Whispering Pines Native Non-Profit Homes Inc.


Whispering Pines has now received approval for the project and the Town must now declare the lands in question (per attached survey) as surplus per our Surplus Land Policy and the Municipal Act.

#### Recommendation:

That the Town of Mattawa declares part of the road allowance between Concession 12 and 13 (known as Wood Street), Part Lot 2, Range "K" Registered Lot 1 and all of Lot 104 Registered Plan No. 7 as surplus land to accommodate the request from Whispering Pines to acquire the land for their Seniors Housing Complex.

#### **BY-LAW NUMBER 14-29**

WHEREAS it is desirable to close the road referred to in Section 1 of this By-law;

**AND WHEREAS** the lands are not required for highway or other municipal purposes.

## THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MATTAWA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The road described in this Section of this By-law, according to a Plan to be registered in the Land Titles Office for Nipissing as PIN 49102-0299, more particular described as follows:

Part of the Road Allowance between concessions 12 and 13 (known as Wood Street) Parts 2, 3 and 5, Town of Mattawa, District of Nipissing and shown on Schedule "A" to this By-Law.

Is closed as a road for vehicular traffic of the Corporation.

2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date it is passed and when a certified copy is registered in the Land Registry Office, at North Bay Ontario, pursuant to Subsection 34 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001.

Enacted and passed this 11<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 2014 as witnessed by the Seal of the Corporation and the hands of its proper Officers.
