ACT RESPECTING THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION: The Financial Institution collects and uses information on a member in order to let him/her take advantage of the savings and credit financial services and of the complementary services offered by the Financial Institution, including improvements to its products and services and the possibility of offering new ones that better meet his/her needs. This information can be accessed by the Financial Institution's authorized personnel solely when warranted in the discharge of Financial Institution duties. Personal information is kept in the member's file on Financial Institution premises or that of its representatives. A member is entitled, under certain conditions and by contacting the Financial Institution in writing, to consult the personal information held by the Financial Institution concerning him/her and have it rectified when he/she demonstrates that it is inaccurate, incomplete, equivocal or obsolete. Moreover, if the Financial Institution obtains a report from a personal information agent, the member is entitled to access and rectify the file held by such agent by contacting that agent in writing.

Moreover, I understand that in accordance with and to the extent permitted by applicable laws, the Financial Institution may provide my personal information to other Desjardins Group components or third parties. With regard to other Desjardins Group components, the sharing of my information may occur and be used for purposes including risk management, the prevention, detection and investigation of fraud, and the fight against money laundering and terrorist financing.

DECLARATION OF TAX RESIDENCE: The member communicates with the the Financial Institution within 30 days of any change that causes the "Declaration of tax residence" section to become incomplete or inaccurate.

CONSENT: The member consents to the collection by the Financial Institution from any financial institution, consumer reporting agency or employer of the information and employment references that it may deem necessary for managing the operational aspects of his/her folios for the entire duration of the business relationship, such as the authorized transit and funds freeze at the automated teller machine. The member also consents to the disclosure of such information to the Financial Institution by the person thus contacted even if it is found in a closed or an inactive file. The member further expressly authorizes the Financial Institution to release to any lender, financial institution or consumer reporting agency that so requests, any and all information that it requires concerning any credit that may have been granted to the member.

CHEQUES: The member authorizes the Financial Institution to send him/her, by regular mail or otherwise, any and all cleared items or electronic representations thereof and documents concerning the folio or uncleared items relating to his/her transactions. As authorized under the *Bills of Exchange Act*, the member waives any request for payment, notice of dishonour or protest relative to any instrument that he/she might negotiate through the Financial Institution.

CHEQUES DRAWN ON THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION: The member recognizes that the cheques and other items drawn on the Financial Institution and deposited to his/her account are processed by Desjardins Group Clearing Centre. The member consequently grants the Financial Institution the right to debit his/her account within five days of the credit corresponding to the amount of the cheque or items drawn on the Financial Institution, and which would have been returned unpaid for any reason whatsoever. However, in the case of a postdated cheque, the Financial Institution has until the cheque expiry date to debit the company's account.

PASSBOOK OR STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT: The member undertakes to promptly check all entries in his/her passbook or statement of account and to notify the Financial Institution of any error, omission or erroneous entry within thirty (30) days of a passbook update or of the receipt of a statement of account, or, in the case of an electronic statement of account, within thirty days of the date of its availability on AccèsD, that is the day following the end of the statement billing cycle.

In the event that the member cannot abide by the preceding, he/she releases the Financial Institution from any liability and waives all rights relating to the passbook or statement of account entries and cheques, items and other documents which would then be deemed accurate and in order.

OVERDRAFT PROTECTION AND INTEREST ON OVERDRAFT: The member recognizes that the Financial Institution may debit the accounts under his/her folio for the amount of any cheque payable by the Financial Institution, any preauthorized debit or payment order, and any liquid debt owed. The member recognizes that each time the funds in his/her account are insufficient to handle these payments, it is his/her desire that the Financial Institution make an advance to cover the payments. The Financial Institution is under no obligation to grant such a request. Upon request, the member must repay any overdraft amount. All overdrafts are subject to the service charges in effect at the The Financial Institution, including the annual applicable interest rate. The current annual interest rate is 21%.

SERVICE CHARGES AND INTEREST RATES: The member acknowledges having been informed of the applicable service charges and interest rates in effect, as posted at the Financial Institution, which can be modified from time to time at the Financial Institution's sole discretion, and agrees to be bound by them. The member undertakes to pay any and all service charges and expressly authorizes the Financial Institution to debit the accounts under his/her folio accordingly.

AUTHORIZED TRANSIT: The member authorizes the Financial Institution to establish for him/her an authorized transit, being the amount up to which the Financial Institution agrees not to withhold funds on items he/she negotiates on a daily basis. This authorized transit is automatically adjusted following every deposit, whether any withdrawal takes place at the counter or automated teller machine.

FUNDS FREEZE AT THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE: The member acknowledges that the Financial Institution may decide, at its sole discretion and at any time, whether deposits made through the automated teller machine are subject to a two-day automatic freeze, regardless of the authorized transit.

FUNDS TRANSFER: The member agrees to the following conditions regarding the automatic funds transfers he/she asked the Financial Institution to carry out:

- 1. Each transfer shall be approved as if it had been signed each time by him/her.
- 2. The Financial Institution assumes no responsibility if, inadvertently, any funds transfer does not occur.
- Funds transfers scheduled for an unlimited duration will remain effective as long as the instructions in relation thereto are not revoked.

POWER OF ATTORNEY: In the event the member requires a third party to carry out transactions on this folio, the member shall either execute the Financial Institution's form of Power of Attorney or provide the Financial Institution with a Power of Attorney document that is acceptable, in form and content, to the Financial Institution. At all times, the member, acting through an attorney, shall be bound by all terms and conditions herein and the attorney shall abide thereto.

SOLE FOLIO HOLDER: The sole holder of a folio undertakes to reimburse the Financial Institution, upon demand, for all items deposited to the credit of the folio, which cannot be collected, and all service charges established by the Financial Institution. The folio holder authorizes the Financial Institution to withdraw any amount that is due and owing with respect to this folio, from any other folio held at the Financial Institution, including a joint folio, in the event the amounts deposited into this folio are insufficient to cover all amounts. Moreover, the Financial Institution shall remit to the folio holder statements of account or any other item, including electronic representations thereof, relating to this folio.

The folio holder undertakes to reimburse the Financial Institution, upon demand, if an overdraft of the folio occurs or any transaction results in a negative balance.

OVERDRAFT PROTECTION: When the member enrolls in the overdraft transfer available on his VISA credit card, he accepts, if the account thus protected is a joint account or a proxy account, that the joint holder or his attorney may trigger an overdraft transfer on his VISA credit card for any transaction made on the protected account that gives rise to overdraft protection.

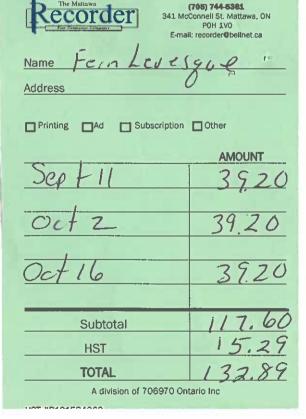
