#### Mayor D. Backer and Members of Council:

A letter from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services, included in the Correspondence section (4.16) of this agenda, has approved a R.I.D.E. allocation for the Town of Mattawa in the amount of \$6,630.00 for 2018/2019. This grant has been applied for and approved by the Province for approximately twenty years now and in order to participate, the Ministry requires the municipality to enter into a transfer payment agreement.

The attached agreement outlines the specifics about the program and the by-law authorizes the signing of the contract. In summary, the grant will provide 100% of the costs of sworn officers' overtime and paid duty.

#### **Recommendation:**

That the Town of Mattawa approves By-Law 18-24 which authorizes the signing of a transfer payment agreement with the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services for the R.I.D.E. Grant Program for 2018-2019 in the amount of \$6,630.00.

#### **BY-LAW NUMBER 18-24**

**BEING** a by-law to authorize the signing of a transfer payment agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario hereby represented by the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services ("the Province") and the Mattawa and area Police Services Board (Group of 4) hereby represented by the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa for the fiscal 2018/2019 R.I.D.E. Grant Program.

**WHEREAS** Section 5, subsection 3 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, C. 25, empowers and authorizes Council to pass by-laws enacting agreements.

**AND WHEREAS** the attached transfer payment agreement, Appendix "A" outlines the funding agreement details and therefore forms part of this By-law.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa enacts as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the aforesaid agreement on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa in accordance with the terms and conditions referred to in this agreement attached to this By-law and known as Appendix "A".
- 2. That this agreement shall be effective and shall remain in effect and force in accordance with the terms of the agreement subject to any amendments thereto or the termination of the said agreement.

#### Mayor D. Backer and Members of Council:

The process of expropriation of the lands described as Lots 64, 65, 66 and 67, Plan 2 in the Town of Mattawa is now finalized.

The last step in this process was to issue a notice of possession along with payment of \$2.00 which represents the municipality's claim to the lands in turn for the outstanding property taxes owing on this property.

The outstanding property taxes total \$17,465.52 and provisions under Section 354 of the Municipal Act, 2001 allows for the write-off of taxes not deemed collectible upon which is the case in this matter.

Council approval is required therefore the following is recommended:

#### **Recommendation:**

That Mayor and Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa approves the write-off of property taxes and interest penalty fees in the amount of \$17,465.52 resulting from the expropriation of the lands described as Lots 64, 65, 66 and 67, Plan 2, Mattawan; Mattawa, District of Nipissing, bearing PIN 49101-0042 as per the provisions under Section 354 of the Municipal Act, 2001 S. O. 2001, C.25 as they are deemed uncollectible.
