The attached By-law is customarily passed at the beginning of each year, which authorizes the Town to borrow money, if needed, to meet expenditures until taxes and grants are received. In the event of short-term cash requirements, it is necessary to have the By-law approved to allow us to borrow.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa approve By-Law #22-02 with ScotiaBank which will allow the municipality to borrow money for the current year, if necessary, until grants and taxes are received.

BORROWING BY-LAW MUNICIPALITIES

BY-LAW NO. 22-02

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa, (the Corporation) deems it necessary to borrow the sum of <u>Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$500,000.00)</u> to meet, until the taxes are collected and other revenues are received, current expenditures of the Corporation for the year.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-Law of the Corporation as follows:

- 1. The <u>Mayor, Finance Chair, General Government Chair or CAO/Treasurer</u> are hereby authorized to borrow on behalf of the Corporation from THE BANK OF NOVA SCOTIA (the 'Bank') from time to time by way of promissory note or bankers' acceptance a sum or sums not exceeding at any one time <u>Five Hundred Thousand Dollars, (\$500,000.00)</u> to meet, until the taxes are collected and other revenues are received, current expenditures of the Corporation for the year <u>2022</u>.
- 2. The <u>Any two of the persons listed above in #1</u> are hereby authorized to sign, make or draw on behalf of the Corporation and to furnish to the Bank from time to time promissory notes or bankers acceptances for the sum or sums so borrowed with Interest or any other charges at such rate as the Bank may from time to time determine.
- 3. The <u>Treasurer</u> is hereby authorized and directed to furnish to the Bank at the time of each borrowing and at such other times as the Bank may from time to time request, a statement showing the nature and amount of the estimated revenues of the current year not yet collected or where the estimates for the year have not been adopted, a statement showing the nature and amount of the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set forth in the estimates adopted for the next preceding year and also showing the total of any amounts borrowed in the current year and in any preceding year that have not been repaid.
- 4. All sums borrowed from the Bank and any interest thereon and any other charges in connection therewith shall, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Corporation for the current year and for any preceding years as and when such revenues are received and that the <u>Treasurer</u> is hereby authorized to sign on behalf of the Corporation and to furnish to the Bank an Agreement or Agreements of the Corporation charging the said revenues of the Corporation with payment of all sums borrowed from the Bank and any interest thereon and any other charges in connection therewith.
- 5. The <u>Treasurer</u> is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed from the Bank, and of any Interest thereon and any other charges in connection therewith, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received on account or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and for any preceding years and all of the monies collected or received from any other source.

6. That the <u>Treasurer</u> and <u>Mayor</u> are hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa, the Bank of Nova Scotia's Security Agreement, in accordance with the terms of the agreement attached to this By-Law and known as Schedule "A".
