## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MATTAWA BY-LAW NO. 22-18

BEING a by-law to establish a Reserve and Reserve Funds Policy for the Town of Mattawa.

WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law.
