**BEING** a by-law to appoint a Deputy Treasurer for the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa.

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act (section 228(1) provides that a Council of a Municipality shall pass a by-law for appointing officers and servants as deemed necessary for the purposes of the Corporation;

**AND WHEREAS**, The Municipal Act, Section 286(2) provides that a municipality may appoint Deputy-Treasurers who shall have all the powers and duties of the Treasurer under this and any other act;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Mattawa enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Bonnie Thur is hereby appointed Deputy Treasurer for the Corporation.
- 2. **THAT** the Deputy Treasurer shall exercise all the authority, powers and rights and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by statute or by by-law are or may be conferred or imposed upon and any other duties that may be imposed by Council.
- 3. THAT By-laws 23-20, 21-11 and 17-05 are hereby repealed.
- 4. **THIS** By-law shall be come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.

#### THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MATTAWA BY-LAW 23-28

**BEING** a by-law to appoint a Municipal Clerk for the Corporation of the Town of Mattawa.

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act (section 228(1) provides that a Council of a Municipality shall pass a by-law for appointing officers and servants as deemed necessary for the purposes of the Corporation;

**AND WHEREAS**, The Municipal Act, Section 228(1) provides that a municipality shall appoint a Clerk whose duty is to:

- record, without note or comment, all resolutions, decisions and other proceedings of Council
- If required by any member present at a vote, to record the name and vote of every member voting on any matter or question;
- To keep the originals or copies of all by-laws and of all minutes of the proceedings of the Council;
- To perform the other duties required under this Act or under any other Act; and
- To perform such other duties as are assigned by the municipality.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Mattawa enacts as follows:

- 5. **THAT** Amy Leclerc is hereby appointed Municipal Clerk for the Corporation.
- 6. **THAT** the Municipal Clerk shall exercise all the authority, powers and rights and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by statute or by by-law are or may be conferred or imposed upon and any other duties that may be imposed by Council.
- 7. **THAT** Pursuant to Section 288(4)(5) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Chapter 25, the Clerk may delegate in writing to any person other than a member of Council, any of the Clerk's powers and duties under this or any other Act, and that in spite of this delegation, may continue to exercise the delegated powers and duties.
- 8. **THIS** By-law shall be come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.

#### **RESOLUTION:**

**WHEREAS** the Town of Mattawa recognized the urgent need for physicians in Northern Ontario as it is experiencing a shortage of trained physicians and specialist physicians;

**AND WHEREAS** life expectancy of Northern residents is more than two years lower than the Ontario average, and mental health and addictions are at a four-times higher rate;

**AND WHEREAS** one in eight Northern residents does not have access to a family doctor, and many must travel long distances to access healthcare services representing the failure of healthcare in Northern Ontario;

**AND WHEREAS** communities in Northern Ontario require access to equitable health care, especially underserved rural, Indigenous, and Francophone communities;

**AND WHEREAS** in April of 2022, the Government announced an unprecedented medical expansion for NOSM University's medical programs;

**AND WHEREAS** the current base funding rates for the Northern School of Medicine University (NOSM) have not been increased sufficiently to accommodate growth and expansion.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Town of Mattawa strongly requests the Provincial Government grant NOSM University's request for a permanent increase in annual base funding by \$4.0 million before the end of this fiscal year so it can continue to deliver on the mandate that the Conservative Government initially established in response to the needs of Northern municipalities.

**AND FURTHER THAT** a copy of this motion be forwarded to Premier Doug Ford, Minister of Health and Deputy Premier Sylvia Jones, Minister of Colleges and Universities Jill Dunlop, MPPs Greg Rickford, Vic Fedeli, George Pirie, Ross Romano, Kevin Holland, Association of Municipalities of Ontario, Northern Ontario School of Medicine University, Federation of Northern Ontario Municipalities, Northern Ontario Academic Medicine Association and the leaders of the opposition parties of Ontario.
