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To the municipal partners in the Municipality of Mattawan, Town of Mattawa, Township of Papineau-Cameron,

In the latest forecasts from ORRS and OPG, discharge at the Temiskaming dam is forecast to increase to 1950m<sup>3</sup>/s with Otto Holden forecast to be discharging between 1800 and 2050 m<sup>3</sup>/s over the next 3-5 days.

The gauge is located at the Mattawa Waterfront boat launch. Data is recorded in 5-minute intervals and updated hourly with slight delay. The established start of minor flooding is at 154.23 m (or 54.23 on the gauge readings).

While water levels will increase as a result of higher upstream discharge, water levels are expected to remain below minor flood thresholds. NBMCA continues to monitor forecasts and current conditions and will advise if anything changes.
